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1. College profile

1.1 History, origin and evolution

The college was established by the Salesians of Don Bosco in 1987 to serve the cause of higher education for the people of Garo Hills in particular and North East in general. The college was officially inaugurated by Shri P. A. Sangma, the Union Minister for Labour, on 22nd May 1987 and this date is observed as the College Foundation Day. Fr. V. A. Cyriac the principal made the college what it is today.

The Higher Secondary Section of Don Bosco College was shifted to the present campus on 22nd June 2014 and it is named as '**Don Bosco College: Higher Secondary Section (DBCHSS)**'. It is an educational institution of the Catholic Church, belonging to the global Don Bosco Society and managed by the Salesians of Don Bosco- North East India, with its headquarter in Guwahati, Assam.

The Higher Secondary Section was an integral part of Don Bosco College Tura which was established in 1987 with the intention of bringing higher education within the reach of the people of Garo Hills. The management of the college decided to de-link the Higher Secondary Section from the main college campus in 2014 with a view to ensure quality education at the Plus Two Level. Today, the strength of the teaching staff in the Higher Secondary Section is 30 and the college caters to over 1000 students. The college continues to ceaselessly strive for quality education.

1.2 Infrastructure and facilities

CAMPUS AND INFRASTRUCTURE

Don Bosco College is located in Sylvan surrounding, against the background of the imposing Tura Peak and overlooking a vast expanse of hills, valleys, plains and rivers. The campus, with the breath-taking view, impressive building, pleasing layout, green lawns and shady trees, creates a congenial environment for study and relaxation.

ACADEMIC COMPLEX

The Academic Complex has become the prime tourist attraction of Tura. Considered by many to be one of the finest buildings in North East India, the Academic Complex is vast yet compact structure, housing (a) Administrative Block (b) the Science Block (c) the Arts Block (d) the Commerce Block (e) the Library (f) the Computer Centre.

LIBRARY

The college library caters to the needs of the students with 3500 books approximately- academic, competitive books, magazines, daily news papers, old question banks, etc... The college library also provides the computers with internet facilities for the students to access something to enhance their learning related to their curriculum.

COLLEGE CANTEEN

The college canteen in the campus is specially constructed so that the students need not go out of the campus during class hours. It caters to the students and the staff with reasonable and healthy food with drinking water facility and sitting arrangements.

COACHING CLASSES

All throughout the year , coaching classes are conducted for competitive exams like JEE, NEET.

These coaching classes are specially conducted for aspiring science students.

HOSTELS

The college has three hostels (a) Don Bosco Boy's Hostel which accommodates 120 boys in single and shared rooms; (b) Don Bosco Boy's Hostel Annex which accommodates 30 boys in a dormitory; (c) Auxilium Girl's Hostel where 90 girls are accommodated in shared rooms.

LABORATORY

The college has four laboratories- (a) Biology (b) Chemistry (c) Physics (d) Computer. In these laboratories, about 60 students can be accommodated for the practical at a time.
